OUR PRIVACY IS AT RISK

When we protest, we increase our chance of encounters with law enforcement. With Trump's administration trampling the rule of law, the risk increases to see the government access our phones and computers - our personal data.

Understanding exactly when police can legally search our devices isn't just important — it's necessary for protecting our rights in today's increasingly monitored world.

This month we are inviting Orin Kerr, a professor at Stanford Law School, to talk about the legal aspect of digital security.

When can the government read your email or monitor your web surfing? When can the police search your phone or copy your computer files? In the United States, the answers come from the Fourth Amendment to the Constitution and its ban on 'unreasonable searches and seizures.'

In his presentation, inspired from his book <u>"The Digital Fourth Amendment:</u>

<u>Privacy and Policing in Our Online World,"</u>, Orin Kerr shows how judges must craft new constitutional rules for the new world of digital evidence. Kerr provides a blueprint for legal change with clear rules for courts to adopt to restore our constitutional rights in the computer age.

This will be a hybrid meeting, both in person and on Zoom.

The TWW/I-Los Gatos May Day protest was a success

With over 200 attendants on a week day and a display of artistic and punny signs, we made the news in the Mercury News:

"Hundreds of people gathered in Los Gatos's town plaza around 11:30, carrying signs that denounced deportations, wealth inequality and Musk's government cuts as cars honked around them and speakers blared playing protest songs.

"The idea behind this was to create a safe space for people to come, share their concerns and their commitment to our democracy, get to know each other — if they're not in a group, join one — and to build from here," said Marsha Palitz-Elliott, the rally's organizer."
